


4. Volunteers For Flooded Areas And Landslide Victims:

Conducted By The Ministry Of Youth Affairs And Sports-04,05-09- 2023 The Ministry Of Youth Affairs And Sports, Nss New Delhi, Conducted A Survey Focusing On Youth Between The Ages Of 15 And 29 Who Are Not Engaged In Formal Education Or Regular Employment. The Survey Aimed To Understand The Demographics, Aspirations, Challenges, And Opportunities For This Segment Of Youth. The Survey Was Conducted In The Adopted Village And Nearby Areas By The Nss Unit No. 087 & 179 Of Govt. College Mokeri.

Survey Details:

- Conducted By Nss Unit 87 & 179
- Survey Period: 04-09-2023 To 05-09-2023
- Target Participants: Youth Aged 15-29 Not In Formal Education Or Regular Employment
- Survey Methodology: Interviews, Questionnaires, And Data Collection From Local Sources

Key Findings:

- 1. Demographics: The Survey Gathered Data On Age, Gender, Educational Background, And Socio-Economic Status Of The Surveyed Youth.
- 2. Aspirations: Insights Were Gained Into The Aspirations, Career Goals, And Interests Of The Youth Not In Formal Education Or Employment.
- 3. Challenges: Identified Challenges Such As Lack Of Access To Education, Limited Job Opportunities, Financial Constraints, And Social Barriers.
- 4. Opportunities: Highlighted Potential Opportunities For Skill Development, Vocational Training, Entrepreneurship, And Community Engagement.

The Survey Report Was Submitted To Calicut University On August 31, 2023, As Part Of The Collaborative Effort Between Nss Unit No. 087 & 179 And The Ministry Of Youth Affairs And Sports, Nss New Delhi. The Survey Conducted On Youth Not In Formal Education Or Regular Employment By Govt. College Mokeri's Nss Unit No. 087 & 179 In Collaboration With The Ministry Of Youth Affairs And Sports, Nss New Delhi, Provides Valuable Insights And Recommendations For Targeted Interventions And Programs To Support And Uplift This Segment Of Youth In The Community







16 Free Eye Check-Up Camp-29-09-2023

4. Treatment Continuation: Concessions And Support Were Offered To Individuals Who Required Ongoing Treatment Beyond The Camp.


